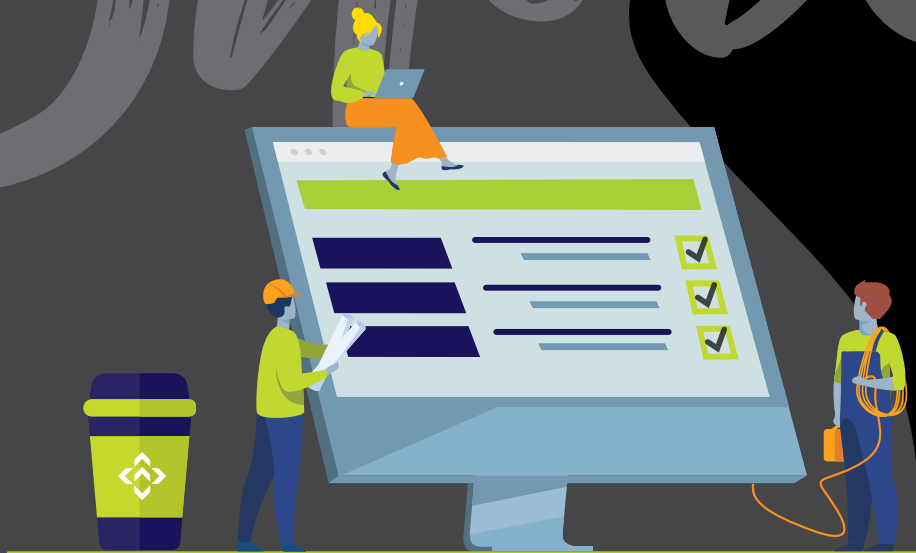

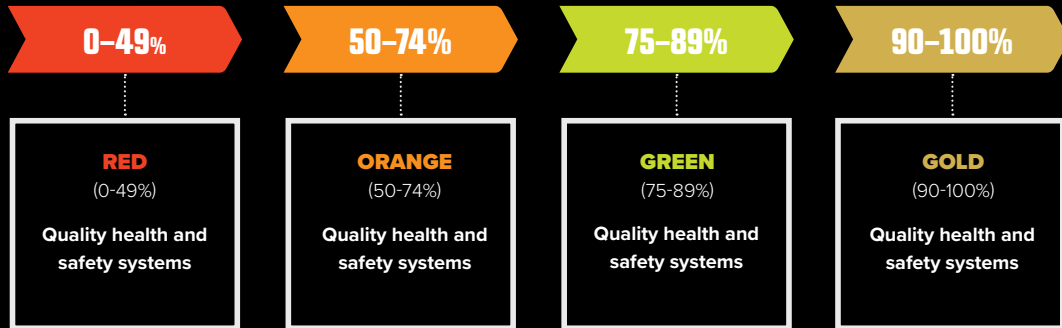
What is SiteWise?

SiteWise is an online prequalification system developed and powered by Site Safe which grades a contractor's health and safety capability.

Contractors complete a 12-step questionnaire, which is assessed by qualified health and safety practitioners. The assessment provides a percentage score, which is published in the SiteWise Contractor Database and can be viewed by main contractors or principal organisations who have signed up to use SiteWise.

Assessment results are recorded in a traffic light system in the database to make it easy for main contractors and principals to see your business' performance at a glance.

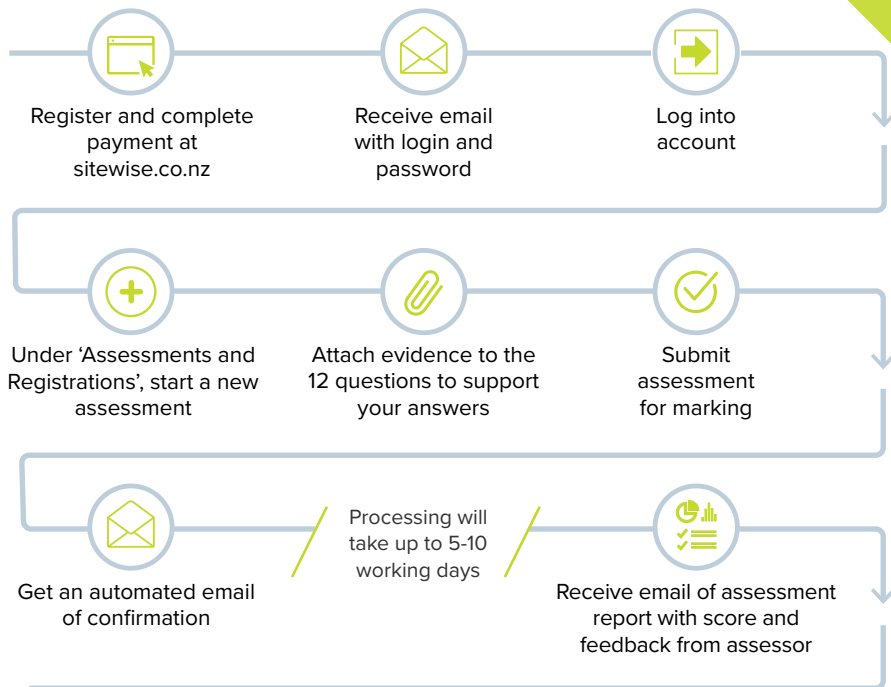
Scores are displayed as follows:



The higher your score, the better you can demonstrate your commitment to good health and safety practices.

Assessment results are valid for a year, you may avoid having to provide prequal evidence on a project-by-project basis.

You can also upload your insurance documents. Contractors looking to hire you can be sure your insurance is up-to-date and you will even receive alerts when your documents are about to expire.

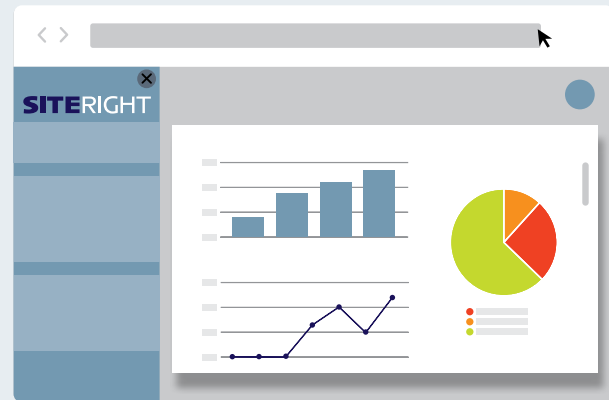
- **Construction Health and Safety Performance Review**

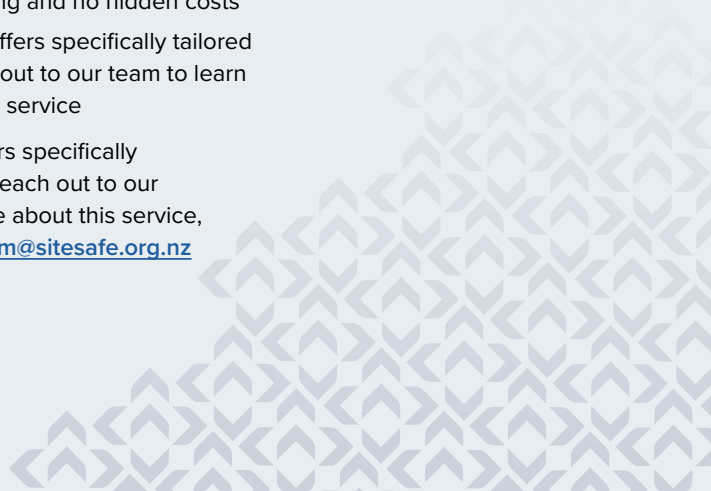

By completing the Health and Safety in Construction programme you will:

- Become a health and safety leader
- Develop your career and skills
- Demonstrate your commitment to health and safety training
- Proudly stand for health and safety in the New Zealand construction industry
- Develop an in-depth knowledge of workplace health and safety requirements and contribute to the wider construction industry in New Zealand

You can choose one of our recommended pathways or you can create your own pathway to achieve your

certificate. Completing this programme will award you with a New Zealand Qualification Authority (NZQA) recognised New Zealand Certificate in Workplace Health and Safety Practice (Level 3).

When customising your own pathway, we recommend you complete the following courses:

You will also need to ensure you complete two of the three mandatory courses:

- Site-Specific Safety Planning

- Risk Management

Apart from the mandatory courses listed above you can choose the courses and workplace evidence that best suits you, provided you achieve a total of 40 credits within five years.

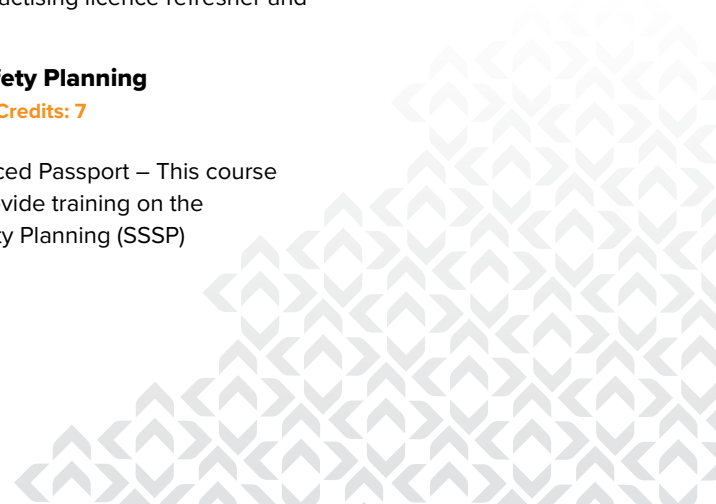

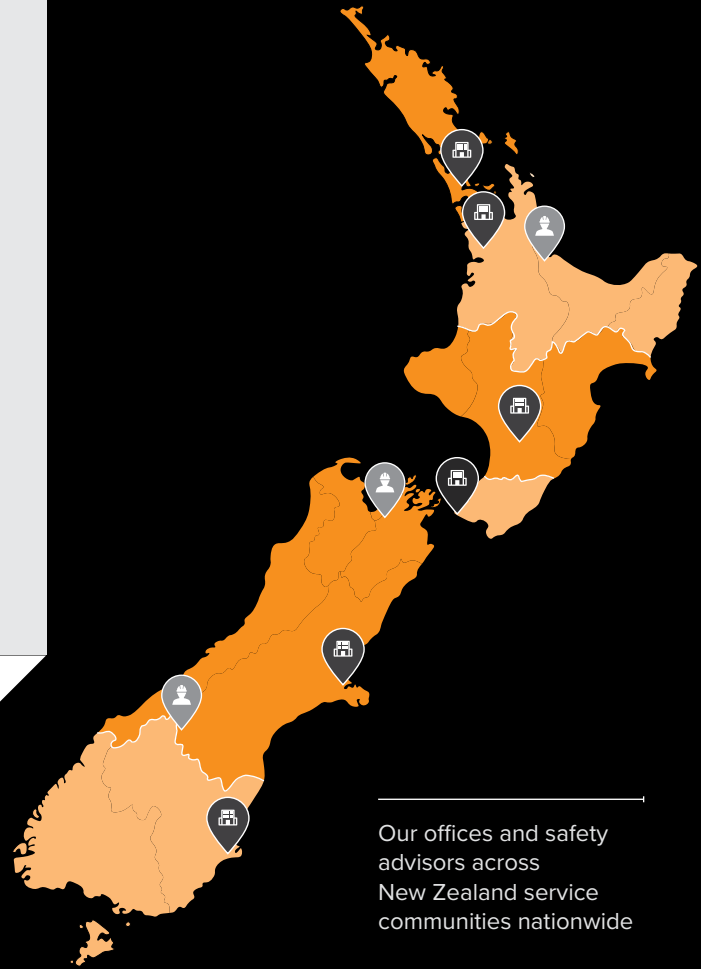
