LEADERSHIP AND ACCOUNTABILITY

We will actively lead and champion a health and safety culture, system and initiatives that support the health, safety and wellbeing of our employees and others.

PLANNING

We will set objectives for our health and safety management system and review them regularly to support continual improvement.

COMPLIANCE

We will comply with health and safety legislation and any other legal requirements applicable to the organisation.

RISK MANAGEMENT

We will maintain risk management systems that identify hazards, assess risks and implement controls. We will give priority to eliminating hazards so far as is reasonably practicable.

TRAINING

We will provide employees with the information, training, support and supervision they need to work safely in their roles and in the workplace.

EMPLOYEE INVOLVEMENT AND PARTICIPATION

We will consult with employees and support their involvement and participation in meeting our health,

safety and wellbeing commitments through open and constructive engagement.

CONTRACTOR MANAGEMENT

We will work with contractors, service providers and visitors so everyone understands and meets their health and safety responsibilities in the workplace.

WELLBEING

We will have strategies, policies and initiatives in place to promote and support employee wellbeing and to eliminate or minimise psychological harm in the workplace.

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT

We will manage workplace incidents, injuries and illnesses through reporting, review or investigation, and prompt action.

REHABILITATION

We will manage rehabilitation after a workplace injury or illness to support an employee's safe and early return to work.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

We will identify emergency preparedness and response requirements for each workplace and put appropriate procedures in place
