Training

Consultancy

The Site Specific Safety Plan is a communication tool between contractors, ensures site info is updated, and health and safety procedures are specific to the job.

SiteWise is a health and safety pre-qualification database for tendering subcontractors. The prequalification procedure will help establish a shortlist of tenderers for main contractors.

The Danger Sign assists site management by alerting public and reminding visitors of on-site safety expectations.

The Hazard Board records new, on-going and unusual significant hazards specific to a site - along with their required control.
